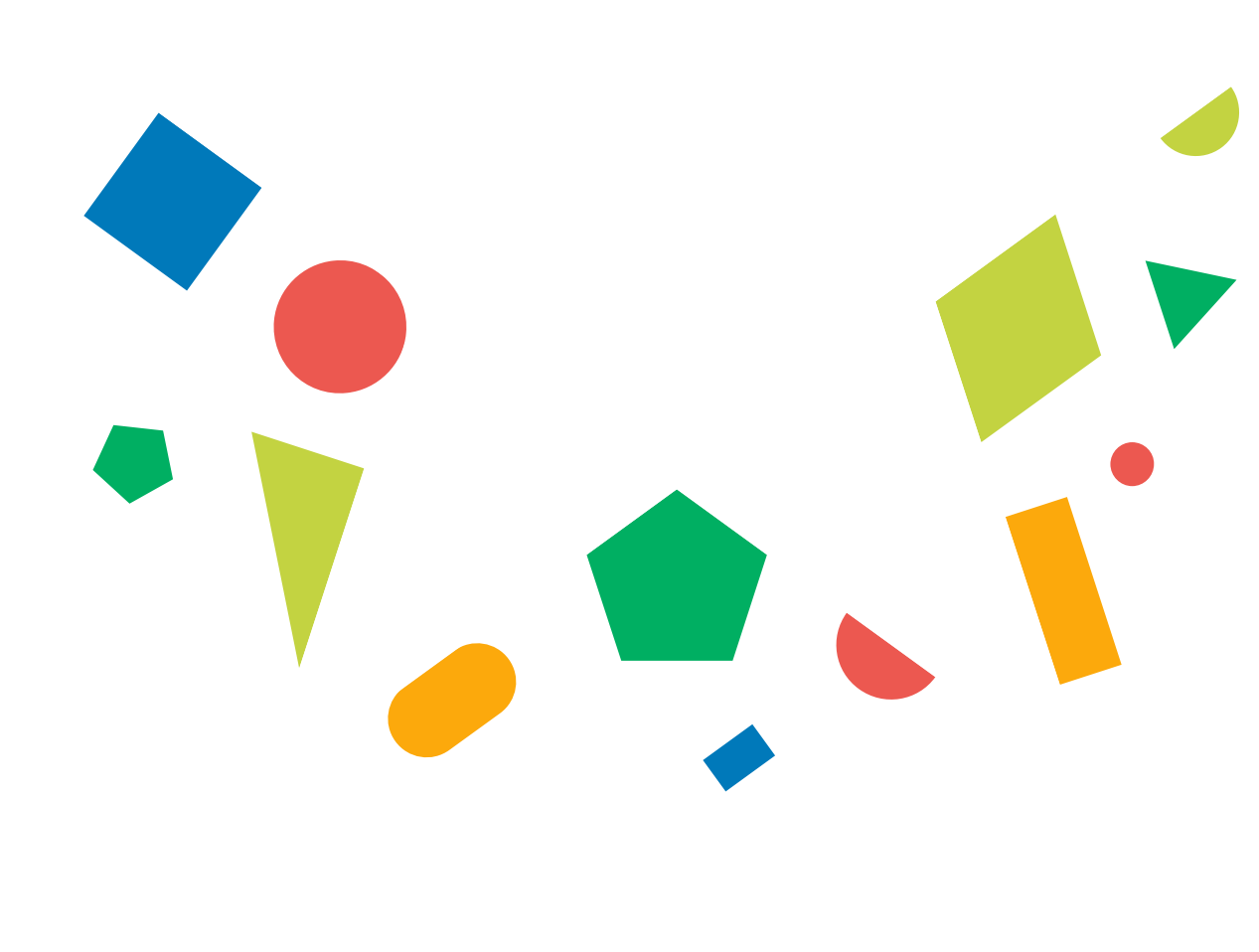

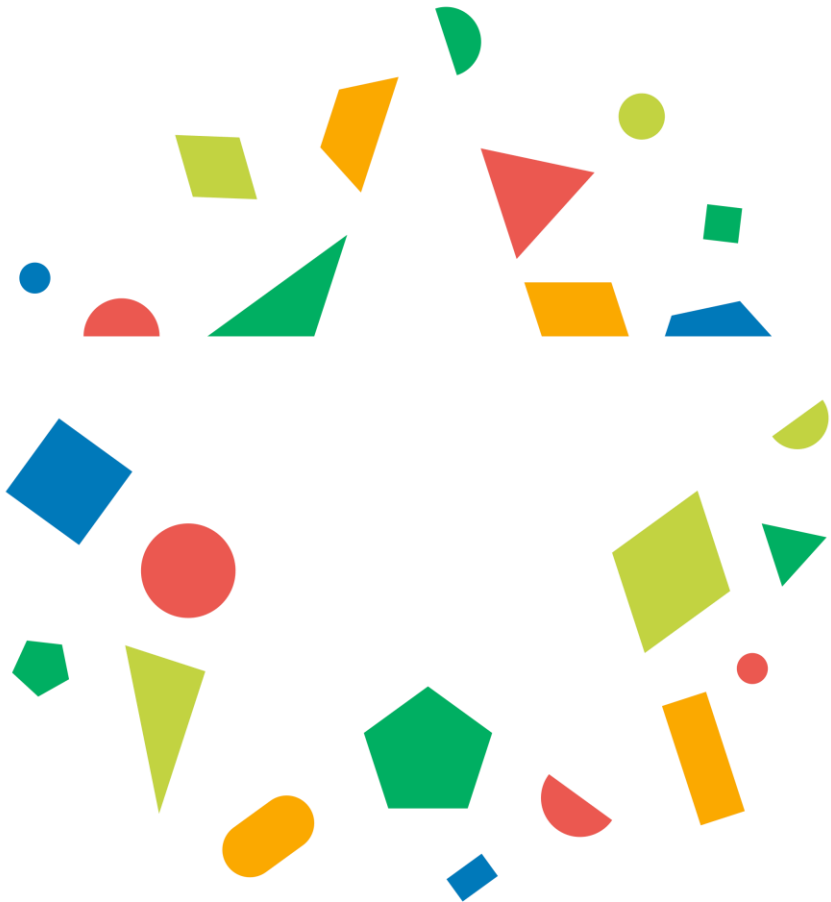

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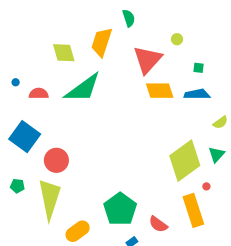

STATE OF PLAY: WHERE DO WE STAND?

(1) TCAs AND NETs IN THE CURRENT PROGRAMMES

TCAs: Transnational Cooperation Activities (Erasmus+ programme)

NETs: Networking Activities (European Solidarity Corps)

(Hundreds of!) activities organized by National Agencies to gather (potential) stakeholders and individual beneficiaries of Erasmus+/ESC:

- Contact seminars between organisations / individuals
- Exchange of best practices
- Thematic sessions (e.g. outreach and integration of people with fewer opportunities / with special needs, ...)
- Evidence-gathering activities
- Community-building activities

STATE OF PLAY: WHERE DO WE STAND?

(2) PROJECT FOR FUTURE TCAs AND NETs

- More possibilities for **national activities** (towards the NET model), in addition to **transnational** ones
- Greater focus on the link to **European policy cooperation** in Education, Training and Youth and **dissemination of programmes results.**
- Importance of the **European-added value** of activities.
- **Long-term cooperation projects** with specific focus.

STATE OF PLAY: WHERE DO WE STAND?

(3) SALTOs/RESOURCE CENTERS IN THE CURRENT PROGRAMMES

SALTOs: Support for Advanced Learning and Training Opportunities

Resource Centers that provide expertise, support guidelines, information and training in specific areas, for National Agencies, stakeholders and other actors.

(They may be involved in the organization of TCAs/NETs!)

(thematic)

- SALTO YOUTH on **Training and Cooperation**
- SALTO YOUTH on **Participation and Information**
- SALTO YOUTH on **Inclusion and Diversity**

(regional)

- SALTO **Eastern Europe and Caucasus**
- SALTO **Euromed**
- SALTO **South-East Europe**
- **European Solidarity Corps** Resource Center(s)

STATE OF PLAY: WHERE DO WE STAND?

(4) PROJECT FOR FUTURE SALTOs

- **Proposed principles for the future SALTOs:**
 - **Building on** the existing SALTOs, and further **extending** their scope, where relevant
 - Identifying **new needs** and challenges for the future
 - Keeping the number of SALTOs **proportionate**
 - Ensuring **appropriate links** between Erasmus Youth and the European Solidarity Corps
 - Ensuring the support to the **international dimension** of both programmes in the future

(4) PROJECT FOR FUTURE SALTOS

- Proposal for “**new needs**” (**thematic SALTOS**):
 - Evaluation/impact/monitoring
 - Policy support, results sharing and outreach

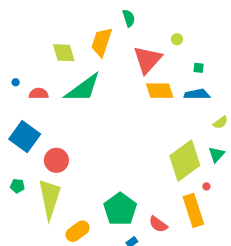

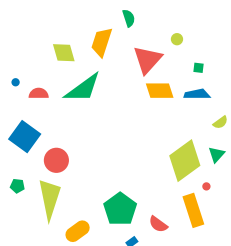
