## C5 - New IT systems, better user experience

### ***About this session...***

Project organisations and coordinators need easy-to-use IT systems to apply for funding and manage their projects. They also need to be able to find all key information for successful projects quickly and easily.

For the new programmes, we are working to replace the current ecosystem of standalone IT systems with a series of interconnected modules designed to provide a seamless user experience. These modules will be accessed through a single entry point and web address.

We are calling this single entry point the 'Erasmus+ and European Solidarity Corps platform' and it will present you with the most relevant information according to your profile. For example, project coordinators will see their draft applications, submitted and ongoing projects and with a simple click go to the relevant module to manage them. The platform will also provide access to useful resources and services. It will thus become the starting point for all organisations wishing to participate in the new programmes.
