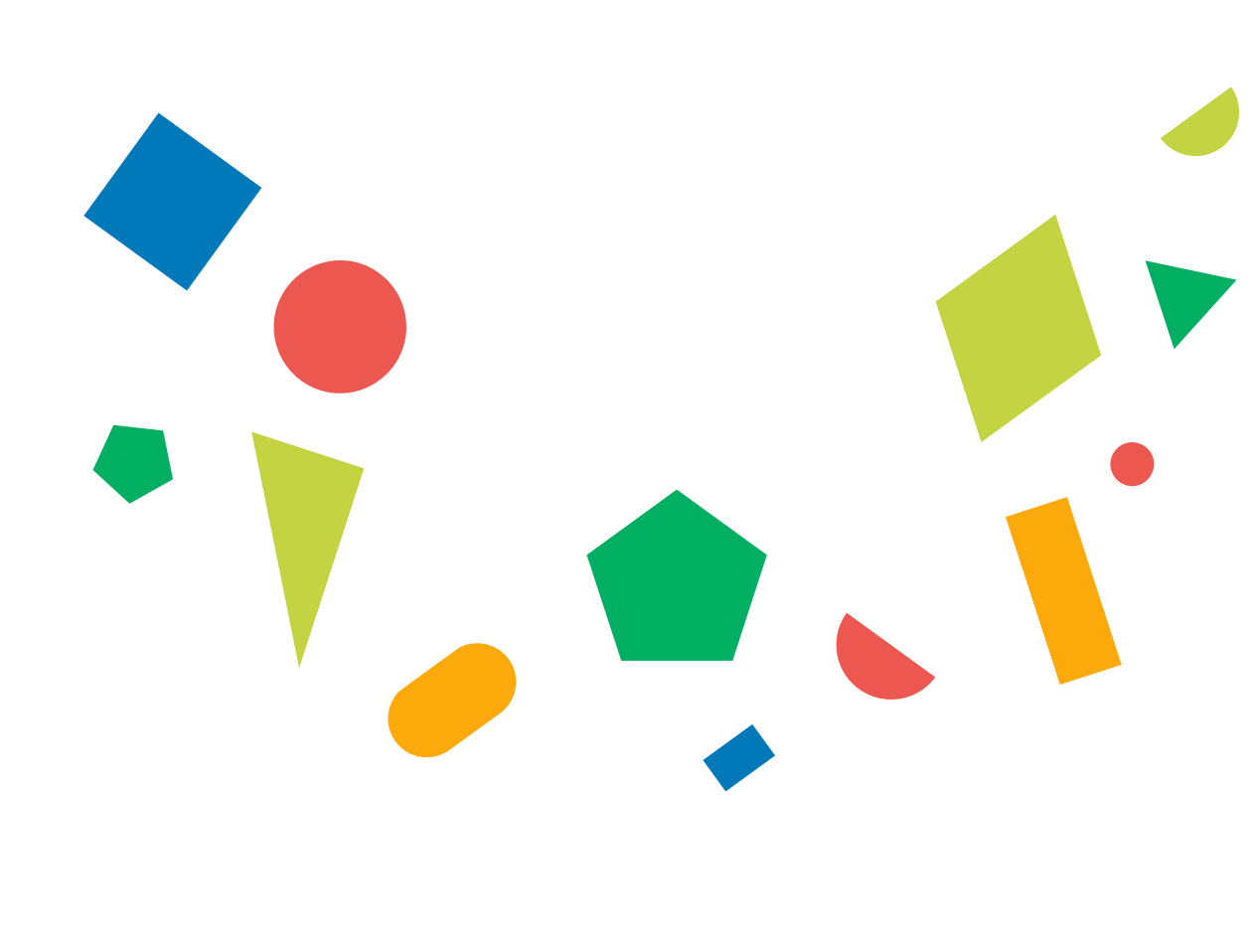
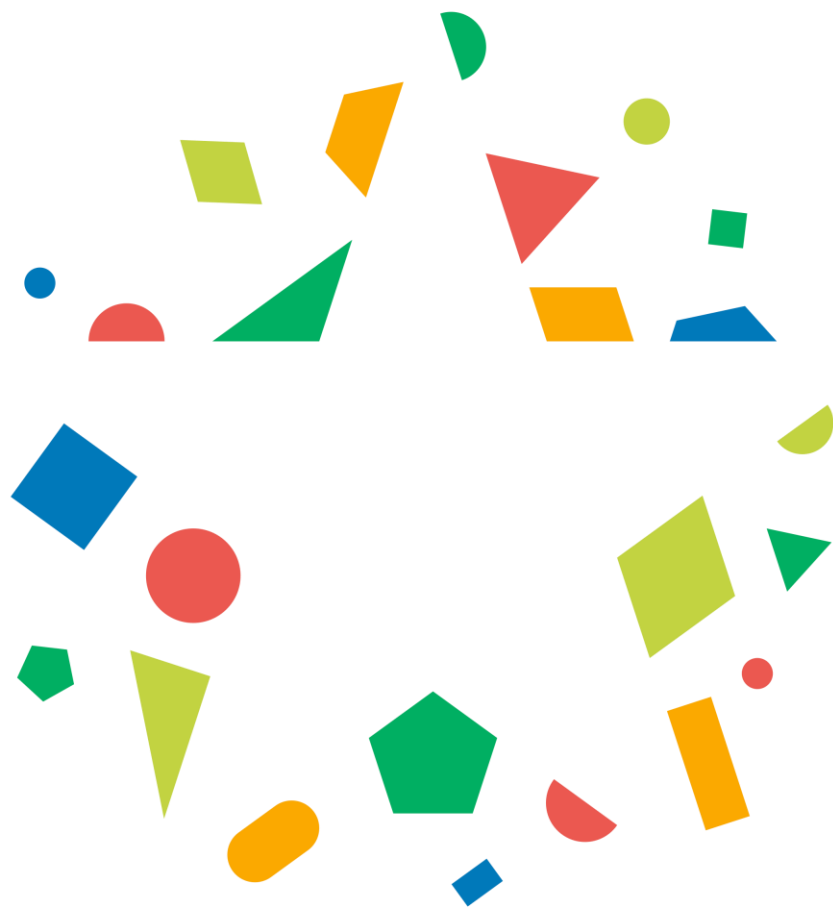

The European Solidarity Corps has been extended and upscaled to offer more solidarity opportunities for young people to engage in solidarity.

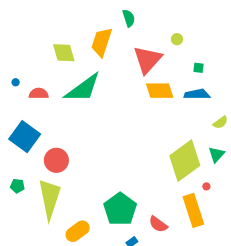
Highlights of the 2021-2027 programme:

- Complementary activities

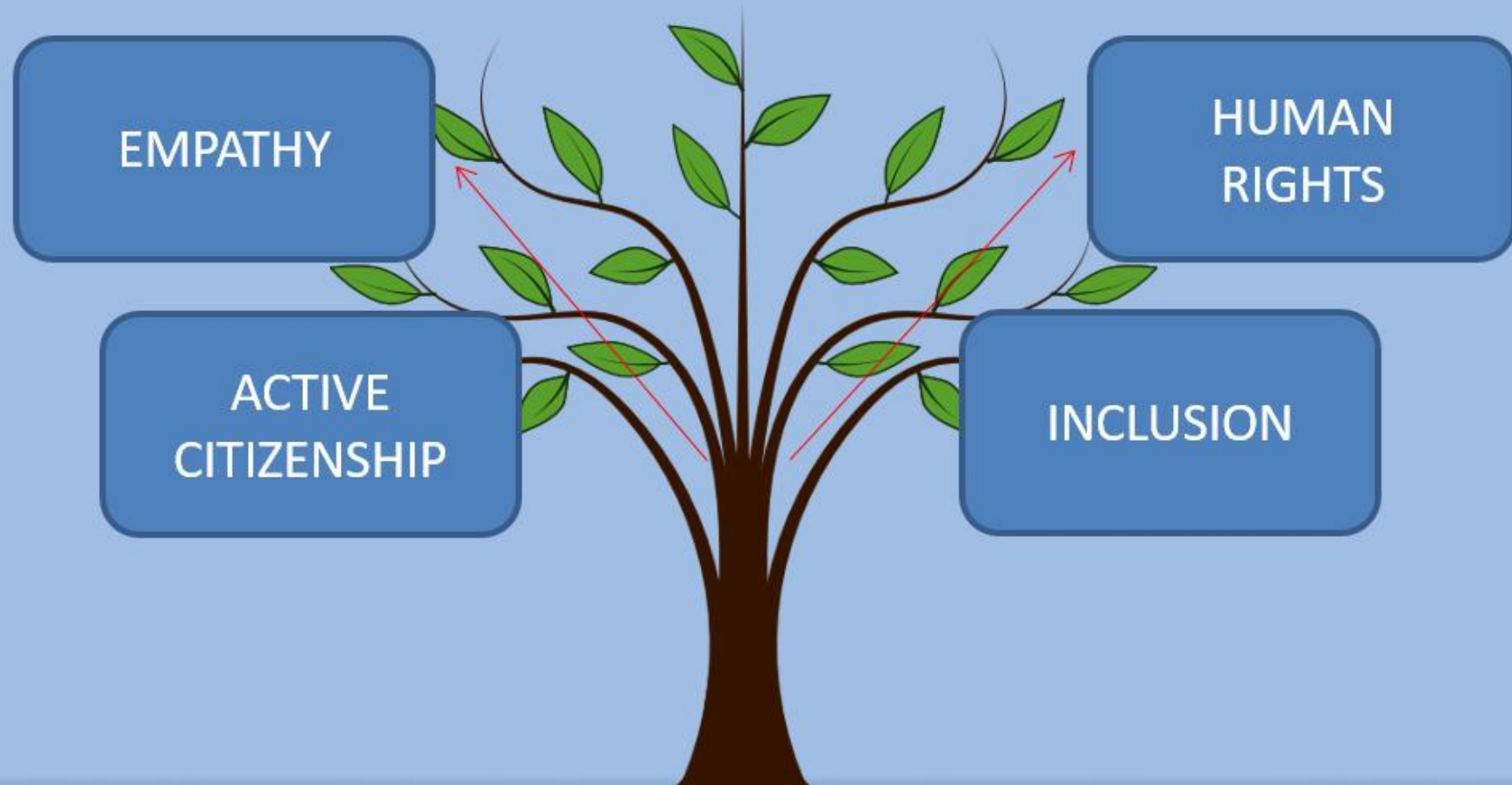
Ongoing: discussion on eligibility and award criteria
