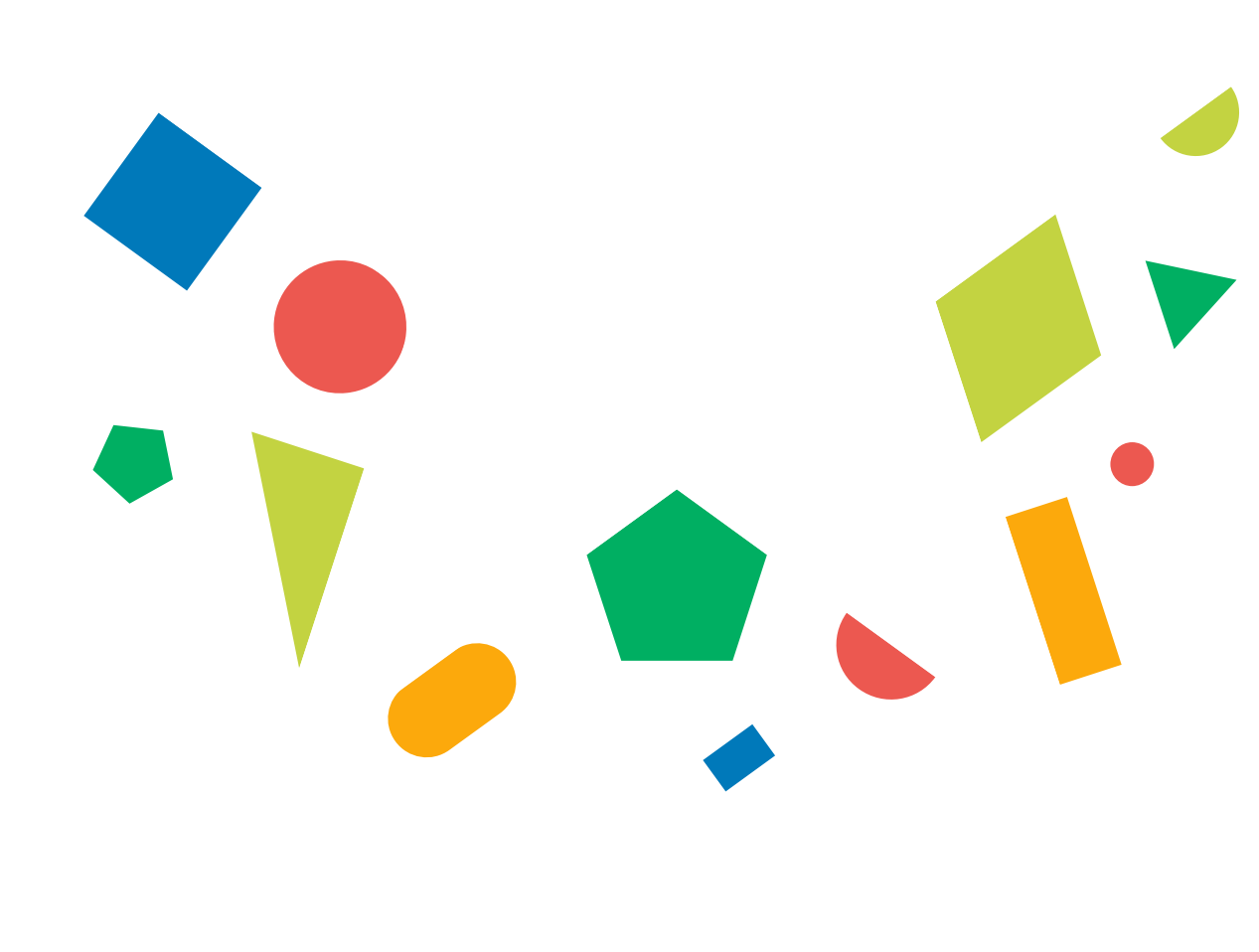
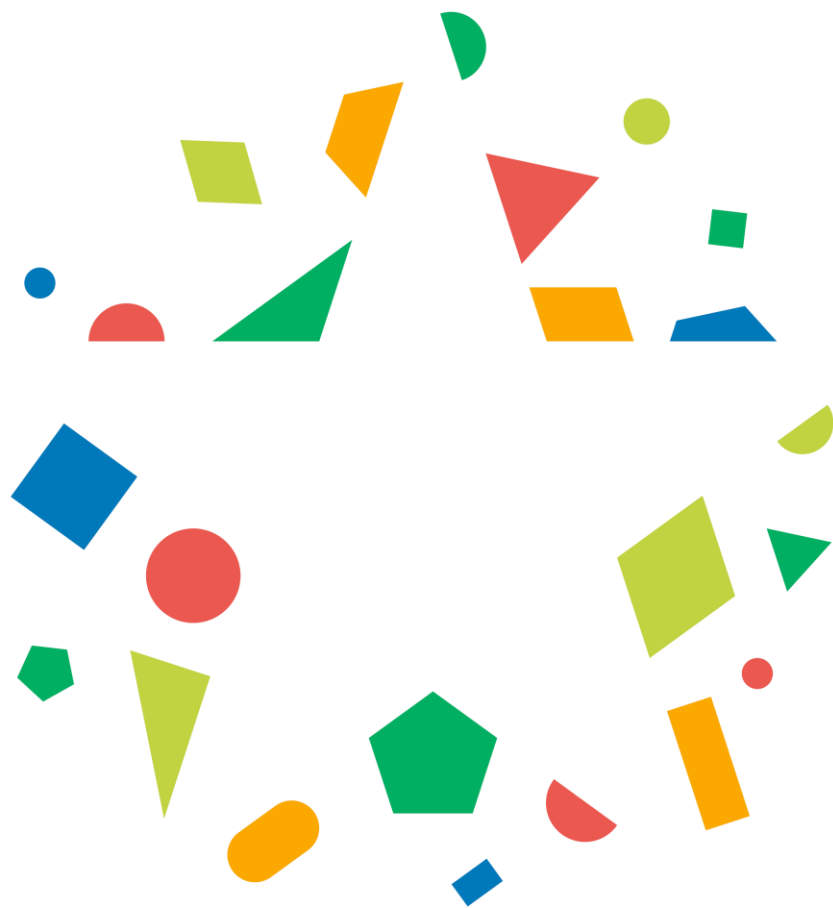

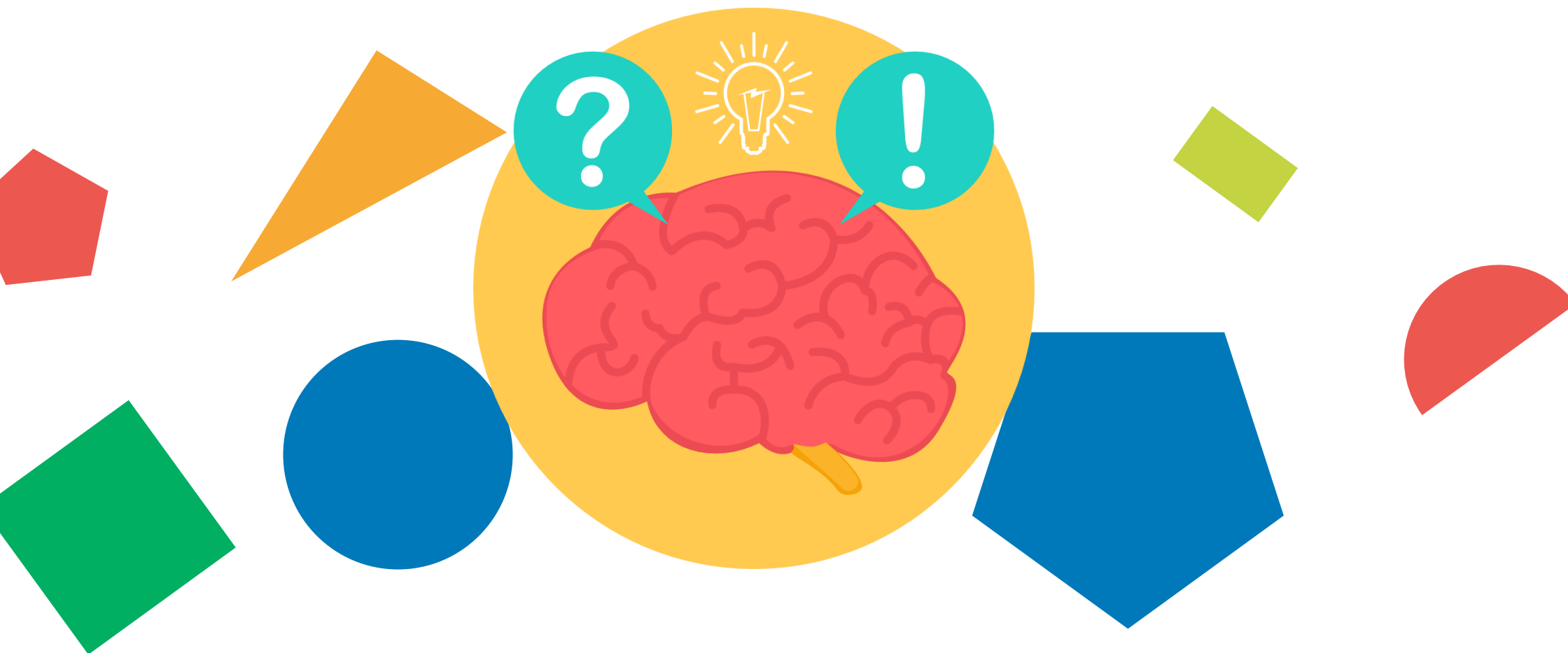

# ERASMUS ACCREDITATIONS IN KEY ACTION 1

- **An accreditation - What is it?**

- A certificate, a membership, a plan. Once it is approved, it lets your organisation receive funding regularly, over a period of multiple years

- **For whom is it?**

- For any organisation in adult education, vocational education and training, school education, or youth. It is **NOT** only for big or experienced organisations.

- **How to join? What to expect in an application?**

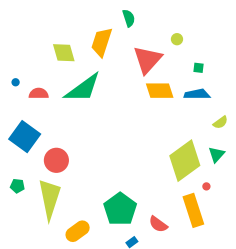
1. Think about what your organisation, staff and learners need
2. Turn that into goals of what to improve
3. Explain how mobility activities can help you do it



# ERASMUS ACCREDITATIONS IN KEY ACTION 1

- **Why use accreditations?**

- Allow organisations more time to pursue their goals, establish good partnerships abroad, and evolve within the programme
- Reduce administration and ask what matters, avoid the details
- Focus more on quality
- Start building communities and networks across borders, aim for long-term results and impact



# EUROPEAN SOLIDARITY CORPS QUALITY LABEL

An adapted Quality Label for the next generation of the European Solidarity Corps... why?

- Facilitate access to funding
- Encourage long-term planning
- Increase volunteering, traineeships and Jobs opportunities
- Focus on quality

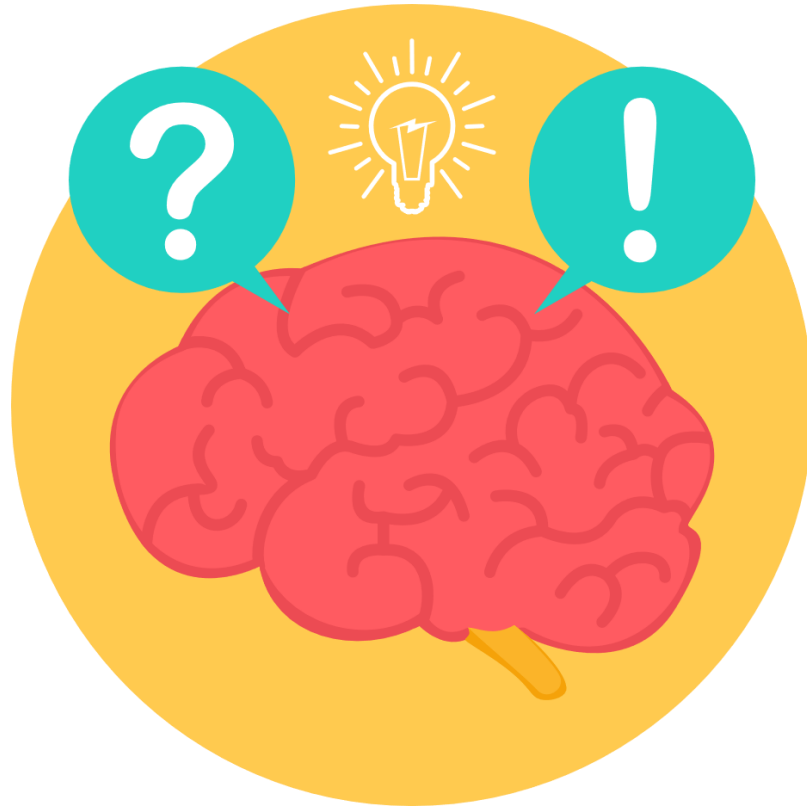
How will it work?

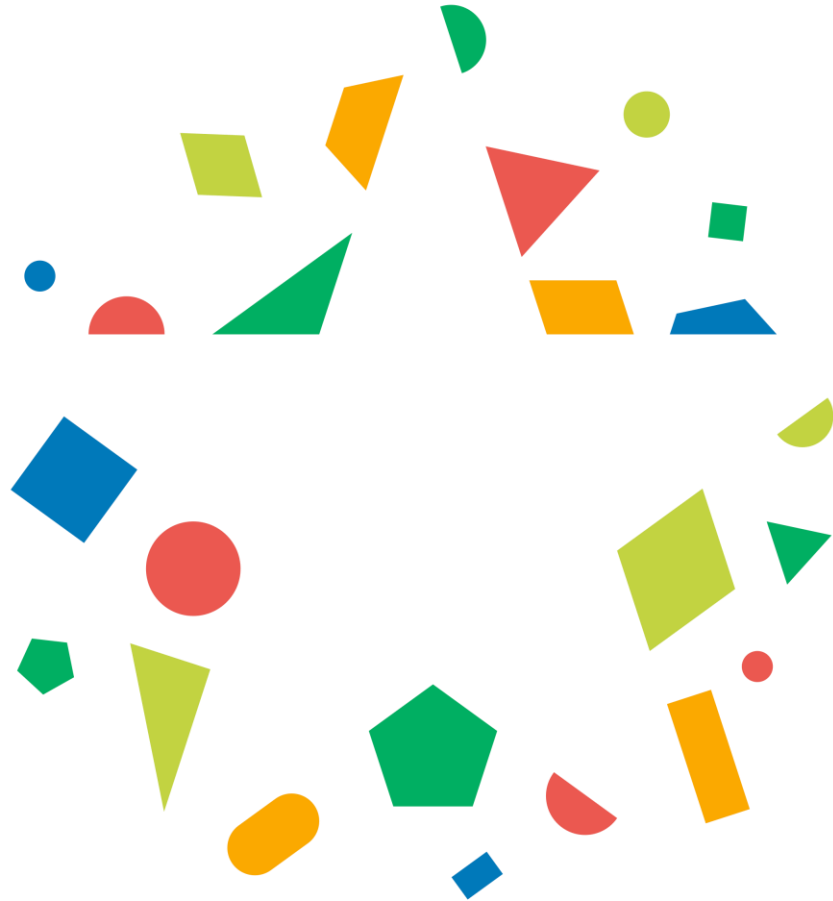
